

## **Instructor Training Course Options**

## National Course

- Class size limited only by conference room accommodation
- Posted on the S.T.A.B.L.E. web site
- Promotions (brochure) unlimited attracts participants from all over the country even Europe!
- All S.T.A..B.L.E. components taught including Cardiac Module course format 2 full days of instruction
- Two instructor-trainers required
- Instructor expenses include travel, honorarium, hotel, meals, etc.
- Book order every participant must have a book (Learner manual for Learner course participants, Instructor manual for Instructor course participants, Cardiac manual for Cardiac module participants).

## **Private Course**

- Participation limited to local/perinatal region staff/faculty
- Maximum 50 participants per day in Learner and Instructor course
- No limitation on participant numbers in Cardiac course
- Course not posted on the S.T.A.B.L.E. web site
- Choice of whether to include Cardiac Module or not course format 1-1/2 or 2 days of instruction
- One instructor trainer required, however additional instructor may be required for Cardiac module
- Instructor expenses include travel, honorarium, hotel, meals, etc.
- Book order every participant must have a book (Learner manual for Learner course participants, Instructor manual for Instructor course participants, Cardiac manual for Cardiac module participants, if Cardiac module offered).

## Online Course – expected launch date: Late Fall/Winter 2006

- Screening application for qualification as Lead Instructor submitted to national office (required)
- Registration fee (to be determined) includes S.T.A.B.L.E. instructor manual
- After application approval, a time limited (three month) login name and password will be provided to applicant
- Upon completion of the online course a certificate will be available to print
- After completing the online course, "virtually attendees" will then be required to attend and be an active participant in a pre-approved S.T.A.B.L.E. learner course taught by a National Lead Preceptor (located throughout the country and worldwide) within three months to complete their training
- Lead Preceptor verifies completion of the Learner course and submits completed certificate to the National office to register the new Lead instructor

- Web training enables the instructor-trainee to complete the instructor section at anytime and the convenience of attending a locally taught learner course
- Maximum of 3 instructor-trainees allowed per learner course
