Program description

This National Instructor Course will provide an overview of the S.T.A.B.L.E Program and will prepare expert neonatal nurses, physicians and respiratory therapists for the Support or Lead Instructor role. This fast-paced program is designed for those already familiar with the S.T.A.B.L.E. Learner/Provider course. Additional background information will be presented that will help instructor candidates understand the rationale for certain program guidelines.

Pre-requisite for Attendance and Instructor Candidacy

Current S.T.A.B.L.E. Learner/Provider Course completion card or current Support Instructor registration. Instructor course candidacy is also contingent upon successful completion of the pre-test provided at the course (passing score is 70% or higher) and post test that was provided at your most recent full-length learner course (passing score is 85% or higher; no re-testing permitted).

Students unfamiliar with PowerPoint or using SecurePack files may bring their own laptops to run the "sample" program slides that will be provided at the course. This will allow an opportunity to learn how to navigate the SecurePack program slides and animations and to receive additional help as needed. Please note, you will not be receiving the complete Program Slides from the Learner CD ROM, but a sample of some of the animations and an explanation on how to navigate SecurePack. The slides are PC compatible only (not Mac compatible).
